THE BIG YELLOW LOWDOWN:

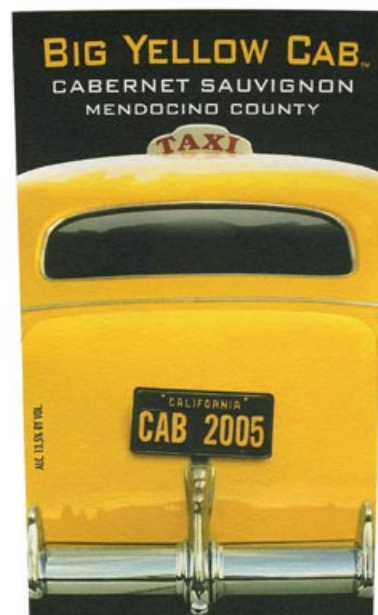
That classic 1940s style — bold and romantic, sophisticated but street-savvy — seemed just right for what we put in the bottle, so we put it on the outside, too.

TIP A SIP AND ENJOY THE RIDE:

Black fruit aromas of plum and berry mingle with a whiff of toasty oak and just a suggestion of cedar. The mouth feel is medium rich, with flavors of juicy pomegranate, tangy dried cherry and a light touch of clove spice.

The silky smooth finish recalls evenings of deserted, steamy streets and glowing street lamps. With plenty of flavor and character, Big Yellow Cab is the perfect vehicle for any number of fares: grilled T-bone steak, pasta puttanesca, or a hunk of first rate gouda.
