VINTAGE



The long and even ripening conditions of the season translated to grapes of excellent quality. A very

wet winter gave way to a cool spring that allowed for the grapes to mature gradually. This extended, cool growing season led to wines with rich flavors, fresh acidity and outstanding balance.

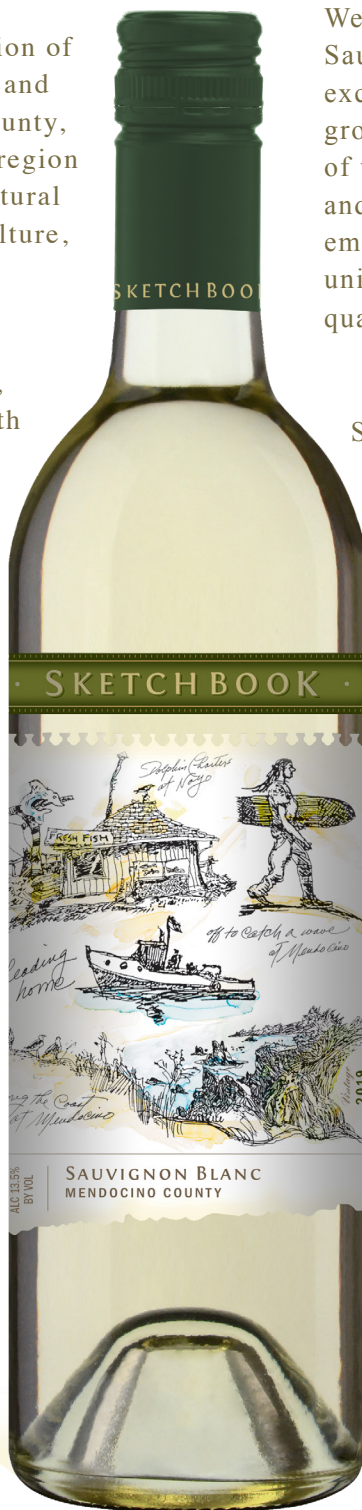

TASTING NOTES

We delight in the crisp tastes of Sauvignon Blanc crafted with exceptional grapes grown near the banks of the Russian River and winemaking that embraces each wine's unique varietal qualities.



WINEMAKING

Sourced from the Ukiah and Potter Valleys, these warm inland valleys in Mendocino County allow exotic citrus and tropical flavors to develop in the Sauvignon Blanc, while the cool nights in the region help the grapes retain crisp acidity during long hang times in the vineyard. The grapes are pressed to stainless steel tanks to ferment at cool temperatures to retain the natural flavors developed in the vineyard. The result is mouthwatering wine with zesty acidity and layers of varietal fruit and lemongrass.
