VINTAGE

The long and even ripening conditions of the season translated to grapes of excellent quality. A very wet winter gave way to a cool spring that allowed for the grapes to mature gradually. This extended, cool growing season led to wines with rich flavors, fresh acidity and outstanding balance.

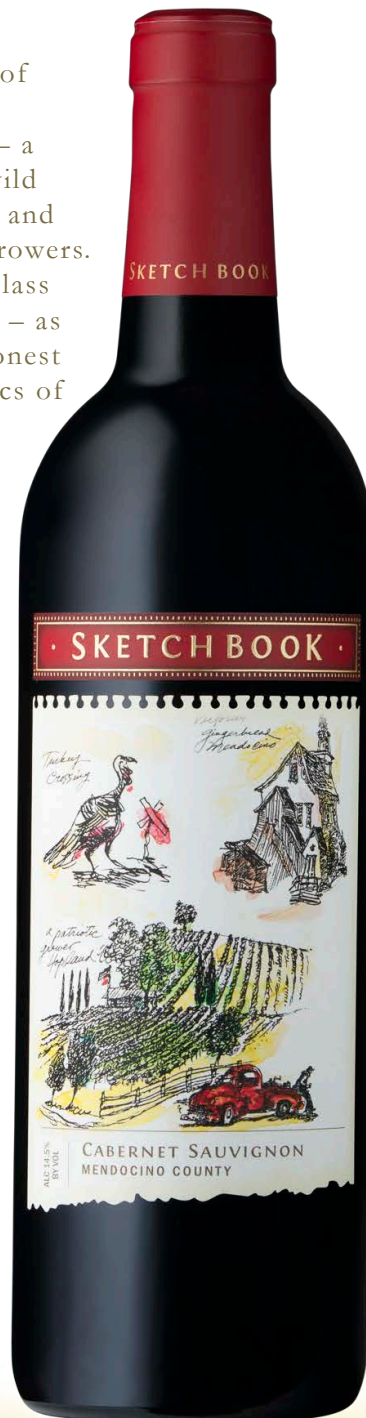

TASTING NOTES

Mendocino County's rocky hillsides grow Cabernet Sauvignon grapes of remarkable character and complexity. Aromas of summer herbs and dried red fruits carry through to flavors of red cherries and subtle oak on the palate.



WINEMAKING

This Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from Redwood Valley and Ukiah Valley, two unique Mendocino County microclimates. Redwood Valley's cooler temperatures contribute acid structure and balance, whereas the warmer temperatures of Ukiah Valley lead to a richer, fatter Cab profile.

3.24% Cabernet Franc
2.39% Petit Verdot
2.36% Petite Sirah
1.59% Grenache
1.48% Syrah
