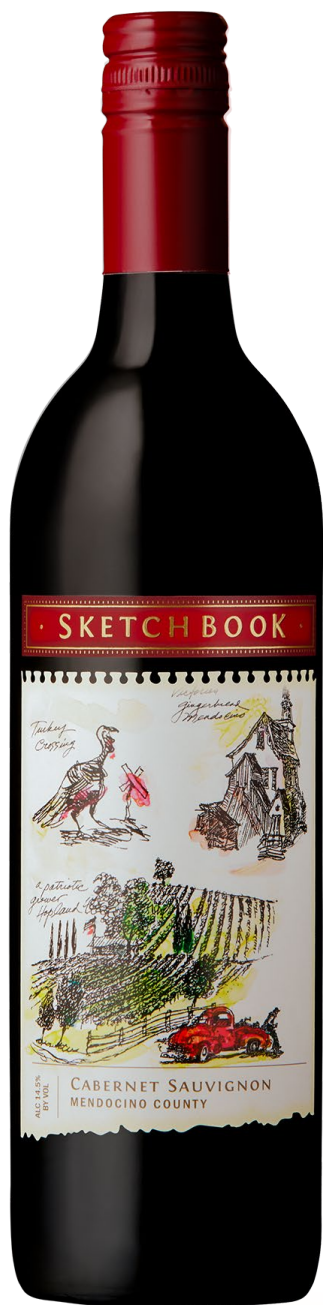

HISTORY

Sketchbook Mendocino Collection is an expression of the real people, places, and tastes of Mendocino County, Northern California - a region celebrated for its wild natural beauty, free-spirited culture, and generations of independent grape growers. Each Sketchbook wine is a master class in the art of observation, beginning - as great artworks do - with humble, honest attention to the unique characteristics of each vineyard, vine, and vintage.

TASTING NOTES

A rugged and majestic region with 97 percent mountain land, and winegrowing spanning from warmer inland regions to the cool Pacific Ocean, Mendocino County's rocky hillsides grow Cabernet Sauvignon grapes of remarkable character and complexity.

Sourced from two unique Mendocino microclimates, Redwood Valley and Ukiah Valley, the wine strikes the perfect balance between acid, structure, and the richer, rounder Cabernet Sauvignon of a warmer climate. Earthy aromas on the nose are complimented by bright red fruit and notes of caraway. Medium weight, the palate is full with good acidity and powerful fruit flavors of cherry and dark plum that carry through to a lingering finish.
