During the early 1900's California saw an influx of Italian immigrants. Many of these immigrants started vineyards and wineries in California, including Mendocino County. Zinfandel was a favorite of these pioneering Italians, and over the years has built a reputation as a hallmark varietal in Californian winemaking.

The 2022 growing season started off dry, followed by significant rainfall in March and April, leading to an early bud break. In September, the region experienced a heatwave, accelerating ripening and making for an intense harvest. The result, smaller than usual clusters with concentrated flavors and good acidity.

Tasting Notes

This voluptuous Zinfandel boasts aromas of blackberry and currant with hints of clove and anise. Vibrant red fruit flavors of jammy strawberry mingle with notes of dark chocolate covered raspberry, and earthy notes of tobacco and spice. It is an indulgent, playful wine that will tantalize at every sip.
