TASTING NOTES

Bright garnet in color with aromas of pomegranate, cranberry, and black cherry married with hints of cedar and vanilla. Notes of cherry carry through to the palate, complimented by flavors of summer berries, clove, and a kiss of toasted coconut. A medium bodied wine with elegant tannins, balancing rich juicy fruit with soft spice that carries through to a pleasing, well-rounded finish.
