### HISTORY

Sketchbook brings to life the wines of Mendocino County – a region celebrated for its wild natural beauty and over 150 years of winemaking tradition. Drawing from this rich heritage, each wine is a masterpiece, expressing the region’s unique terroir and artistry.

The Sketchbook Pinot Noir label showcases an ancient valley oak amidst rolling hills and lush vines, a quintessential image of the region. The Valley Oak, an iconic tree, symbolizes the resilience and grace of the region's terroir, inspiring a wine of elegance and finesse.

### TASTING NOTES

Rich, ruby-red in color, the Sketchbook Pinot Noir greets you with aromas of ripe raspberry, red currant, and a hint of freshly picked plum. On the palate the vibrant berry flavors are complemented by layers of dark cocoa, tart dried cherries, and a kiss of roasted hazelnut. Bright and lively, with smooth tannins, it is a wine of delicate balance, weaving together lush fruit with subtle spicy notes.
